

Homework

On Monday of each week students will receive a *Sneak Peek at the Week*. This is a list of tentative topics and activities we will be exploring in class as well as the homework. Typically, homework is due the following day. Homework is graded based on completion using a five point scale.

Late Work

Late work will be accepted, however students will not be able to earn full credit. A maximum of 4 (out of 5) points will be possible.

Absences

Students are encouraged to keep up with assignments even if they are absent from school. If an absence occurs because of illness the students will be allowed one day for every day they are gone, to turn in homework for full credit.

Grades

Trimester grades will be determined based on points in the following weighted categories:
